Olympic Torch Relay

The Olympic flame in Gouvia Marina

On Thursday 5th of August the Olympic flame landed at the cricket field of Gouvia Marina. From there the first torchbearer

started the Olympic torch relay, transferring the flame to the city cross roads. The flame ended up at the town's main square where several celebration events took place.

In a journey that lasted some 78 days, the Olympic flame, covered a distance of more

than 78.000 km, throughout the world and light every prefecture of Greece.



Beyond the borders of Greece the Flame, in the hands of 3.600 Torchbearers, travelled to Africa and Latin America for the first time and it finally returned to all the previous Olympic cities. A total of 260 million people had the opportunity to see the Flame in their city.

2 Months before all the Works End in Zea Marina
