1. Lefkas Marina mooring capacity increase.

The increased mooring needs led to the marina's expansion by the addition of 600m of floating pontoons. Apart from its mooring capacity which increased by up to 640 berths from 420, the marina is even safer and more protected. Marina manager, Spiros Dallos commented: "I am delighted with the conclusion of the marine works as it improves the operation of the marina. Berth demand had been much higher than what we could meet. Now with the new capacity of the marina, more yacht owners will be able to moor and enjoy its modern amenities".

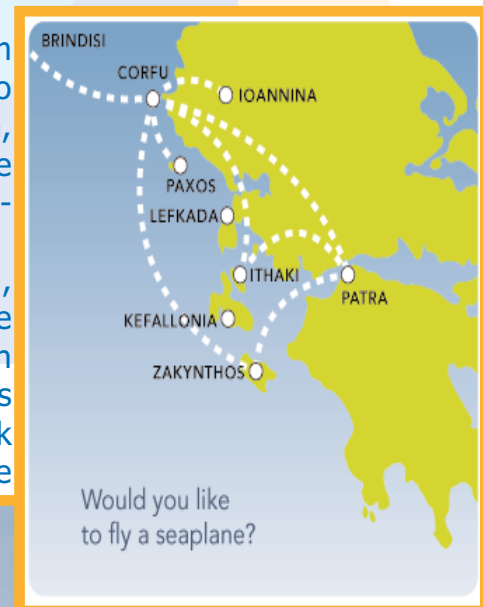


2. Sea planes in Gouvia & Lefkas marina. The new Airsea lines Base in Lefkas Marina.
