The personnel of the marinas had to immediately secure the polluted area with special temporary oil booms to prevent the expansion of the fuel leak. 8. 2006 IMS-600 World Sailing Championship in Aghios Nikolaos - CRETE

Aghios Nikolaos hosted the biggest Offshore Sailing event in Greece, the 2006 IMS-600 World Sailing Championship, during 9-17 September 2006.

The 2006 IMS-600 World Sailing Championship is a very prestigious race in the calendar of the Offshore Racing Congress. The IMS-600 class includes sailing boats of about 40 feet. They are built to the highest standard of quality and design and their crews are amongst the most experienced sailors in the world.



This event was under the patronage of the Ministry of Tourism and the Secretariat General of Sports.

The races took place around the Bay of Mirabello. The venue for the race was the Marina of Aghios Nikolaos which offers up to date facilities to host such a prestigious event. There was also a full program of social events for the entertainment of the participants as well as an exhibition area in the Marina.
